ULTRASOUND ABDOMEN AND PELVIS

FINDINGS:

Liver appears normal in size (14.7 cm), shape and echopattern. No focal parenchymal lesions identified. No evidence of intra/extrahepatic biliary tree dilatation noted. Portal vein appears to be of normal size.

Gall bladder is moderately distended. No definite calculi identified. No evidence of abnormal wall thickening noted. CBD is normal.

Spleen appears normal in size (10.3 cm), shape and echopattern. No focal parenchymal lesions identified.

Visualized portion of pancreas appears normal in size, shape and echopattern. No definite calcification or ductal dilatation noted.

Right kidney appears normal in size measures ~ 9.4 x 2.3 cm, cortical thickness 7.2 mm with **increased cortical echogenicity**. Corticomedullary differentiation appears maintained. No evidence of calculi or hydronephrosis.

Left kidney appears normal in size measures ~ 8.5 x 3.5 cm, cortical thickness 9.6 mm with **increased cortical echogenicity**. **Mild loss of corticomedullary differentiation noted**. No evidence of calculi or hydronephrosis.

Urinary bladder is well distended and appears normal. No evidence of abnormal wall thickening.

Prevoid : 500 cc.

Postvoid : 5 cc.

Uterus anteverted and appears normal in size measuring ~ 8.1 x 3.5 x 3.5 cm. Myometrial echoes appear normal with no focal lesions identified. The endometrial thickness measures ~ 12.5 mm.

Minimal POD fluid noted.

Both ovaries appear normal in size and echopattern.

No evidence of ascites.

IMPRESSION:

- **Bilateral chronic medical renal parenchymal disease. Left grade II, right grade I.**
